OUTSTANDING YOUNG BAND DIRECTOR

Erik R. Cooke-Stone

Erik Cooke-Stone has just completed his third year as an Assistant Band Director with Dodge City High School and Director of Bands at Comanche Middle School. As a member of a team leading the “Pride of Southwest Kansas” he sees over 400 students almost daily. Since graduating with his bachelor's degree in Special-Instrumental Music Education from Wichita State University, Erik has had tremendous success working with students at all ages. Under his direction and dedication student enrollment has only increased. His students have consistently received top ratings at both the middle and high school levels. It is obvious that his students love and respect him as much as he does them.

In the spring of 2016, with the help of the teachers, administration, and staff of Comanche Middle School, he co-founded the new MSWAC Music Festival allowing an opportunity for over a thousand students to perform in large ensembles, small ensembles and as soloists for adjudication. These performers were both instrumental and vocal students. In recent months Mr. Stone has had experience with being a clinician for several band departments across the state. He was most recently asked to be the guest conductor and clinician for the Youth for Music Middle Level Honor Band hosted by Emporia State University in early February of next year.

When the summer season is in full bloom you can find Mr. Stone working with private lesson students in addition to guest conducting for the Cowboy Municipal Band for the city of Dodge City. As an active Lions Club member, he has worked most summers since 2010 with the Kansas Lions Band hosted by several Kansas universities across the state. Mr. Stone was invited to conduct in this year's state band hosted by Friends University, under the direction of Dr. John Taylor. Erik has just recently returned home from Chicago where he was one of the band directors for the Kansas Lions International Band. These students performed in the Lions Club International centennial parade and at the Lincoln Park Zoo.

Mr. Stone is a member of NAFME, KMEA and the KBA. When he is not actively working on all things band related, Erik can be found at home enjoying the company of his two dogs and his husband, most likely singing to his favorite musicals. Mr. Stone is excited and grateful for being recognized with this absolute honor.
